Rule sheet

ALL ENTRIES...

1. All entries must be identified with a banner or sign displaying the name of your organization. (i.e.: Girl Scout Troop #351)
2. All entries must be in line by 8:00am on October 3rd.
3. Candy or other items maybe handed out along the side of the street and not thrown into crowds.

FLOAT ENTRIES...

1. All floats **MUST** follow the parade theme.
2. All parties walking or riding in parade **MUST** be dressed in theme of parade.

PERFORMING ENTRIES...Bands, Equestrians, Cheerleaders, Poms, Dancers, etc...

1. Please be prepared to perform several times during the parade route (on James Street, on Lockport St, and on Illinois Street in heavy spectator areas) keeping the Parade moving and enthusiastic.
2. All participants **MUST** be visibly in the uniform or costume of the organization that they represent.

ALL OTHER ENTRIES...Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, Sports Teams, Politicians, ETC...

1. All participants **MUST** visibly be in the uniform of the organization that they represent.
2. Please display a slogan that has reference to our parade theme.
3. Strollers allowed only if they are a part of your entry.
